

The Compton Parish Council website was formerly hosted by a Company that had been taken over by Yell. Management changes meant that access to the site was compromised on a number of levels and the site was therefore transferred to a new host. This effectively meant that it was redesigned but remained linked to the original domain www.comptonparishcouncil.co.uk and the reports, documents and images could be copied and transferred.

Regulations introduced in September 2018 mean that Parish Councils and other Government bodies must ensure that public information is readily accessible.

From the website perspective this means that not only should the site be accessible via as many devices and browsers as possible but the layout should also be easy to navigate and where possible assist those with impairments that might impact accessibility. All of the above are subject to what is 'reasonable burden' and the site gained 91% approval and a pass when tested against the WCAG 2 criteria.

The site uses images as well as concise text to locate and navigate the relevant sections with longer documents added as PDF downloads. Contacts are currently linked to the Clerk, Joanna.

The site does not have a particularly high number of users because it is restricted to Parish Council information only. Some areas combine their Parish Council, social and Village sites. Compton has a village website and a Facebook page, all however link to one another and each links to the Telephone Box which has become a point of interest.

Most users are from Surrey, however the site is used throughout the SE and abroad (some links from Suffolk and France will be from Karen and me).

363 visitors accessed the site from a desk top computer, 83 from a mobile and 22 from a tablet.

Pages in order of popularity are the home page followed by the cemetery, news, meetings and reports, contact and council info.

The projects page could benefit from some updating and any low resolution images (taken on my old mobile) might also look better if replaced with higher resolution ones.

Minutes are currently added after approval which means they are usually 2 months old by the time they are added. If Council would like them added earlier then they could be added as unapproved/drafts.

News items and any other relevant updates can be added as and when. I.e. Any support / contact details during the Covid -19 situation.
